- Any Letters of Community Service
For verification of Community Service time, a note on the organization's **official letterhead** signed by your supervisor or advisor is sufficient, to be submitted to the Recording Secretary. In the note should be referenced your name and PCC ID #, the total time volunteered, and a summary of the service.
- All and most recent unofficial transcripts
For PCC, your unofficial transcripts may be obtain from lancerlink.edu
- Completed at least 30 Community Service hours, in which 6 are AGS hours
- Attended at least 6 AGS meetings, unless you have otherwise been excused by the Recording Secretary.
- Have the application form, letters, transcripts, checklist, and any other papers necessary enclosed in a manila envelope and date-stamped on the seal.
- Lastly, please submit your completed enclosed application to the AGS mailbox (CC105) **by Wednesday, Nov 23, 2011 before 3:00 PM.**
